

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 125 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 10" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 17 & 20-15-10 ON THE COUNTY LINE. THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 39.62 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 16, 17 20 & 21-15-10
  - 2) 39.63 CHAINS WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 & 20-15-10
  
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 36, A JOINT **PERMANENT SURVEY** IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 217 DATED JANUARY 2, 1902 ORDERED BY D. C. HOUCK FOR A PERMANENT SURVEY IN SECTIONS 19 & 20 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 9" X 12" X 15" STONE AT ONE FOOT EAST OF A FENCE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE HALFWAY BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT STONE THAT FOUND LOOSE ON THE GROUND AND **HE RESET** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10, AND THE GOVERNMENT STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 2,591' EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10
  - 2) 2,591' WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND LOOSE ON THE GROUND AND **HE RESET** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10
  - 3) 3,899' WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 3" X 12" X 15" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-10
  - 4) 5,207' WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND LOOSE ON THE GROUND AND **HE RESET** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-10
  - 5) 7,732' WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-10 ON THE LYON, WABAUNSEE AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE
