

NORTH 1/16 CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 36, A JOINT **PERMANENT SURVEY** IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 217 DATED JANUARY 2, 1902 ORDERED BY D. C. HOUCK FOR A PERMANENT SURVEY IN SECTIONS 19 & 20 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 6" X 9" X 20" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AND **HE RESET** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10 THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,300' WEST TO THE 5" X 12" X 30" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-14-10
- 2) 1,300' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AND **HE RESET** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10
- 3) 1,325' NORTH TO THE 5" X 9" X 24" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-10
