

**WEST 1/16 CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, ALONG WITH W. S. WHITLOCK, WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 88, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 168 DATED DECEMBER 30, 1903 AT THE REQUEST OF M. W. LANGLEY, W. M. JOHNSON, W. W. PATTERSON, AND J. H. SMITH FOR A SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 23 AND THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 15 OF RANGE 10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET A FLAG** FOR THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-15-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-15-10 AND THE FLAG THAT HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 2 ON PAGE 14 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 156" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 20.01 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-15-10
- 2) 60.08 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 18" X 7" X 3" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-15-10, FROM WHICH A **WITNESS STONE** STANDS 12 LINKS EAST AND 7 LINKS SOUTH
- 3) 80.11 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 15" X 7" X 3" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-15-10
- 4) 100.14 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 12" X 6" STONE HE FOUND IN THE GROUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-15-10 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE
- 5) 140.24 CHAINS NORTH TO THE GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-15-10 IN WABAUNSEE COUNTY
- 6) 20.01 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE FLAG HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-10
- 7) 60.04 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE LOCATION FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-10
- 8) 140.09 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 35-15-10 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL, IN THE CENTER OF THE ROAD AND SOUTH OF A STONE WALL ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE ROAD
