EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER SIX IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 6 DATED FEBRUARY 18-20, 1884, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 28-15-10 FOR MARSTELLER, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-15-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH STONE THAT HE SET ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-15-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 23 ON PAGE 183 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON FEBRUARY 22, 1884, AND SURVEY F28001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-10.
