EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER SIX IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 6 DATED FEBRUARY 18-20, 1884, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 28-15-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-15-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 23 ON PAGE 183 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON FEBRUARY 22, 1884, AND SURVEY F28001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-10.

- 2) 20.48 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE HE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-10
- 3) 40.52 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 28-15-10
- 4) 60.56 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-10
