

**CENTER 1/4 CORNER SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 4 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 97 & 98 DATED JANUARY 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF 80 ACRES ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10, SAID THAT HE ESTABLISHED THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 BY RUNNING FROM ONE 1/4 CORNER TO THE OPPOSITE ONE AND AT THE POINT OF INTERSECTION **HE PLANTED A STAKE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10.

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 2) 20.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 3) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 4) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 5) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 6) 20.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 7) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
