- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 4 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 97 & 98 DATED JANUARY 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF 80 ACRES ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10 ON LINE AND EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE POST THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 AND THE CORRESPONDING CORNER ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 30-15-10 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE CORRESPONDING POINT ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 2) 20.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 3) 40.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 4) 20.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 5) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
