

**NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 29 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 16" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19 & 30-15-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 38.86 CHAINS EAST TO THE 16" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 & 30-15-10.
  - 2) 78.86 CHAINS EAST TO THE 16" X 10" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19, 20, 29 & 30-15-10
  - 3) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 12" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-10
  - 4) 80.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-10 ON THE NORTH COUNTY LINE
  
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 203 DATED MAY 2-3, 1901 GAVE NOTICE THAT A SURVEY WILL BE MADE IN SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 19 BY F. H. HANNAH, MORRIS COUNTY SURVEYOR, AND THAT HE WOULD ATTEND AND WITNESS THE SURVEY IN THE INTEREST OF THE RESIDENTS OF LYON COUNTY, SAID THAT **HE SET A 3" X 8" X 18" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A PLUS ("+") ON THE WEST FACE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE ON LINE WITH THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10, LEAVING THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 AT 1-1/3 FEET EAST OF THIS LINE ON THIS PERMANENT SURVEY. SEE PACKET "M 52" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.  
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 20.03 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
  - 2) 40.07-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 THAT WAS 1-1/3 FEET EAST OF THE LINE BETWEEN THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 AND THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
  - 3) 80.15 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
  
- 3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 36, A JOINT **PERMANENT SURVEY** IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 217 DATED JANUARY 2, 1902 ORDERED BY D. C. HOUCK FOR A PERMANENT SURVEY IN SECTIONS 19 & 20 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY.**
