

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 29 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 16" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19 & 30-15-10
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 14" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-15-10
- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 4 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 97 & 98 DATED JANUARY 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF 80 ACRES ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 ON THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE ON THIS SURVEY.
- 3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 203 DATED MAY 2-3, 1901 GAVE NOTICE THAT A SURVEY WILL BE MADE IN SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 19 BY F. H. HANNAH, MORRIS COUNTY SURVEYOR, AND THAT HE WOULD ATTEND AND WITNESS THE SURVEY IN THE INTEREST OF THE RESIDENTS OF LYON COUNTY, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 ON THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY** ON THE COUNTY LINE. HIS NOTES SAID THAT HE SET THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 IN LINE WITH THE STONE THAT FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10, LEAVING THE STONE AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 AT 1-1/3 FEET EAST OF THIS LINE. THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 52" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
- HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 40.07-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
 - 2) 20.04-1/2 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
 - 3) 40.07-1/2 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 3" X 8" X 18" STONE MARKED "X" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 4) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 15-10 SHOWS A "**MONUMENT**" AT THE "W1/4 CORNER SECTION 30-15-10" ON THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE, BUT DOES NOT DESCRIBE THE MONUMENT. THE TIES BELOW IN TIE BOOK NUMBER 13 INDICATE THERE IS A **STONE** AT THIS CORENR.
- 1) 23.5' WEST TO AN OAK POST
 - 2) 19.6' EAST TO A LARGE POST
 - 3) 30.0' SW TO AN IRON PIN

- 5) KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK 13 ON PAGE 65 AT THE TOP OF THE PAGE SHOWS A **STONE** AT THE "W1/4 CORNER SECTION 30-15-10" ON THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE.
- 1) 23.5' WEST TO THE NEAR FACE OF A LARGE OAK POST
 - 2) 30.0' SW TO A 3/4" DIAMETER IRON PIN
 - 3) 19.6' EAST TO THE NEAR FACE OF A LARGE END POST
