

**WEST 1/16 CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 4 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 97 & 98 DATED JANUARY 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF 80 ACRES ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, ALL IN SECTION 30-15-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10 ON LINE AND EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 AND THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10 ON THIS SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 2) 20.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 3) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 4) 60.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 5) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-10
- 6) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE CORRESPONDING CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF SECTION 30-15-10
