- 1) ON PAGE 2 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 8" X 3"** ON THE NORTHEAST SLOPE OF A STONEY POINT FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-10 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL ON OCTOBER 1, 1855.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 24" X 8" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET NEAR THE TOP OF A STONEY HILL FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 31 & 32-15-10
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 18" X 6" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 32 & 33-15-10
