

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 284 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 16" X 12" X 4"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 18 & 19-15-11 ON THE COUNTY LINE. THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.04 CHAINS WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 18" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 18 & 19-16-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 & 20-15-11

- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 117, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 198 DATED MAY 28, 1905 FOR L. N. NANCE, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER FOR A ROAD ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGES 10 & 11, SAID THAT HE AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR W. S. WHITLOCK DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE COUNTY LINE. THEY DID **NOT** RESET THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

- 3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGES 257 THROUGH 260 FOR ROAD NUMBER 597 ON A PETITION BY L. N. NANCE [PACKET 744 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED MAY 1905, SAID THAT HE AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR W. S. WHITLOCK DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE. THEY DID **NOT** RESET THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

- 4) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 58 FOR A PLAT SHOWING THE LINES OF A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO LOCATE THE BOUNDARY OF A TRACT OF LAND IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11 DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING AT A POINT 1,320 FEET WEST OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11; THENCE SOUTH 1,850 FEET; THENCE EAST 235 FEET; THENCE NORTH 1,850 FEET; THENCE WEST 235 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING THAT WAS COMPLETED ON JULY 27, 1971, AND RECORDED IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE IN PLAT BOOK 5 ON PAGE 14-A ON SEPTEMBER 10, 1971, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE "AS LOCATED BY PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22-15-11" ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,085' WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST TRACT CORNER
 - 2) 1,320' WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST TRACT CORNER
