

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 58 FOR A PLAT SHOWING THE LINES OF A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO LOCATE THE BOUNDARY OF A TRACT OF LAND IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11 DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING AT A POINT 1,320 FEET WEST OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11; THENCE SOUTH 1,850 FEET; THENCE EAST 235 FEET; THENCE NORTH 1,850 FEET; THENCE WEST 235 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING THAT WAS COMPLETED ON JULY 27, 1971, AND RECORDED IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE IN PLAT BOOK 5 ON PAGE 14-A ON SEPTEMBER 10, 1971, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET A 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN** AT A DISTANCE OF 1,320 FEET WEST OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST TRACT CORNER ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. **[NOTE: HE DOES NOT CALL THIS IRON PIN THE NORTH 16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING, BUT IT IS SHOWN HERE TO NOTE THE ORIGIN OF THIS 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]**  
**HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
  - 1) 235' EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST TRACT CORNER
  - 2) 1,320' EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11
