

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGES 283 & 284 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 14" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 17 & 20-15-11 ON THE COUNTY LINE AT 40.00 CHAINS EAST OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND 10.60 CHAINS WEST OF THE STONE AT THE CORNER TO FRACTIONAL SECTIONS 17 & 20-15-11 ON THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVE. **[NOTE:** THE STONE AT THE CORNER ON THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVE IS A LIMESTONE 18" X 14" X 2.5" LOCATED 15 CHAINS AND 42 LINKS SOUTH OF THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 16, 17, 20 & 21 AND SET ON PAGE 281 OF THE FIELD NOTES.]
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 & 20-15-11
 - 2) 10.60 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 18" X 14" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET AT THE INTER-SECTION OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS RESERVE
 - 3) 39.30 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 16" X 14" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 16, 17, 20 & 21-15-11
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 198 AND DATED MAY 1905, SAID THAT HE AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR W. S. WHITLOCK DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-10 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY** ON THE COUNTY LINE.
