

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 283 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 & 20-15-11.

- 2) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 72, AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR GEORGE MOSS AND GEORGE W. GORMAN TO SURVEY AND SUBDIVIDE PARTS OF SECTIONS 19, 20 30 & 31 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 72 BUT NOT DATED, SAID THAT **HE SET A TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE MARKED "1/4" THAT MEASURES 4" AT THE TOP, 16" TALL, AND 8" AT THE BASE** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 25 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887 WITH THE NOTATION THAT IT WAS SURVEYED OCTOBER 27 & 28 AND NOVEMBER 6-8, 1884, WITH A COPY OF THIS SURVEY FILED AS SURVEY F19001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-11.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,320' NORTH TO THE 10" X 15" X 3" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11
 - 2) 2,639.5' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE
 - 3) 1,319.5' SOUTH TO THE 10" X 15" X 3" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11
 - 4) 2,639.5' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11

- 3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 117, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 198 DATED MAY 28, 1905 FOR L. N. NANCE, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER FOR A ROAD ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGES 10 & 11, APPARENTLY HE AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR W. S. WHITLOCK DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE COUNTY LINE. THEY DID **NOT** RESET THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

- 4) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGES 257 THROUGH 260 FOR ROAD NUMBER 597 ON A PETITION BY L. N. NANCE [PACKET 744 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED MAY 1905, APPARENTLY HE AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR W. S. WHITLOCK DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE WEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE. THEY DID **NOT** RESET THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
