- 1) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 72, AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR GEORGE MOSS AND GEORGE W, GORMAN TO SURVEY AND SUBDIVIDE PARTS OF SECTIONS 19, 20 30 & 31 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 72 BUT NOT DATED, SAID THAT **HE SET A TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" THAT MEASURES 3" AT THE TOP, 15" TALL, AND 10" AT THE BASE** FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-11 ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 25 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887 WITH THE NOTATION THAT IT WAS SURVEYED OCTOBER 27 & 28 AND NOVEMBER 6-8, 1884, WITH A COPY OF THIS SURVEY FILED AS SURVEY F19001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-11.

WHITLOCK FOUND THE STONE AT THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE COUNTY LINE.**

- 3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 597 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGES 257 THROUGH 260 PETITIONED BY L. N. NANCE AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE IN TOWNSHIPS 15-10 AND 15-11 [PACKET 744 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MAY 28, 1905, WAS GRANTED AS A **50 FOOT WIDE ROAD, 25 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE COUNTY LINE**, ON APRIL 6, 1905 AS NOTED BY W. H. MAPES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND ATTESTED BY W. F. EGGERS, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR**

W. S. WHITLOCK FOUND THE STONE FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE COUNTY LINE. THEY USED THIS STONE, THE STONE THAT THEY FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11, THE STONE THAT THEY FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-15-11, AND THE STONE THAT THEY FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 17-15-11 TO SET A 20" X 14" X 2" STONE FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

- 3) 60.06 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE THEY FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-15-11 IN WABAUNSEE COUNTY
- 4) 100.12 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE THEY FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 17-15-11 IN WABAUNSEE COUNTY
