

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 281 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 15" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 16 & 21-15-11 ON THE COUNTY LINE. THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.23-1/2 CHAINS WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 16" X 14" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 16, 17, 20 & 21-15-11
 - 2) 40.23-1/2 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 35" X 15" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 15, 16, 21 & 2215-11

- 2) IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 188 DATED JUNE 23 TO 29, 1949, AND WITH "L. M. GOULD SURVEYOR" [LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978] WRITTEN IN PENCIL, APPARENTLY DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE AS HE RAN THE COUNTY LINES FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 21-15-11 EAST TO THE IRON PIN THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-21-11 ON THIS SURVEY.
