

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 276 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 30" X 8" X 2-1/2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 14 & 23-15-11 ON THE COUNTY LINE.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 39.81-1/2 CHAINS WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 15" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 14, 15, 22 & 23-15-11
  - 2) 39.81-1/2 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 12" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 13, 14, 23 & 24-15-11
  
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 99, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 179 DATED OCTOBER 4, 1904, FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 15-11 FOR G. E. GORMAN, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, APPARENTLY DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-15-11 AS HE RAN THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-15-11 EAST TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT 30 FEET EAST OF A STONE WALL AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-15-11 ON THIS JOINT ROAD SURVEY WITH THE WABAUNSEE COUNTY SURVEYOR.
  
- 3) IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 188 DATED JUNE 23 TO 29, 1949, AND WITH "L. M. GOULD SURVEYOR" [LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978] WRITTEN IN PENCIL, HE APPARENTLY DID **NOT** FIND THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE AS HE RAN THE COUNTY LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 21-15-11 EAST TO THE IRON PIN THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-15-11 ON THIS SURVEY.
