

**CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 20 DATED AUGUST 9, 1882, FOR A ROAD SURVEY IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11 FOR D. W. LEAVELL, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE CENTER STONE** OF SECTION 26-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,324' NORTH TO THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> SECTION CORNER STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE
  - 2) 2,648' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-11 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 3) 1,324' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 26-16-11 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 205 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 406 TO 408 PETITIONED BY D. W. LEAVELL AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN SECTION 26-15-11 [PACKET 475 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON AUGUST 9, 1882, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 3, 1883 AS NOTED BY HUGH F. HOLMES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 23, 1883 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE CENTER CORNER STONE** OF SECTION 26-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. A NOTE IN RED UNDER THE PLAT STATES: "SEE COMMISSIONERS RECORD #4, PAGE 58 FOR CHANGE IN THIS ROAD. ALSO SEE N. H. PUTMAN'S ROAD, NO. 256 ON PAGE 610 THIS BOOK."

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,324' NORTH TO THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> SECTION CORNER STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE
  - 2) 2,648' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-11 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 3) 1,324' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 26-16-11 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 3) COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 256: THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 610 TO 612 REQUESTED BY N. H. PUTMAN FOR THE LOCATION AND VACATION OF A COUNTY ROAD IN SECTION 26-15-11. IT WAS APPROVED ON APRIL 16, 1884 BY P. Y. HALLBERG, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON APRIL 29, 1884 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK:  
A STRIP OF LAND 40 FEET WIDE OF THE ENTIRE NORTH LINE, AND A STRIP OF LAND 40 FEET WIDE OF THE ENTIRE EAST LINE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-15-11, SAID LAND CONVEYED BY N. H. PUTMAN AND JANE M. PUTMAN, HIS WIFE, TO LYON COUNTY FOR ROAD PURPOSES, BY DEED DATED APRIL 16, 1884, AND RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OF LYON COUNTY IN BOOK NUMBER 30 ON PAGE 49, AND **VACATING** AS MUCH OF THE ROAD GRANTED ON THE PETITION OF D. W. LEAVELL AS LAYS EAST OF AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE SAID FORTY ACRE PIECE OF GROUND ABOVE DESCRIBED.
