

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 72, AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR GEORGE MOSS AND GEORGE W, GORMAN TO SURVEY AND SUBDIVIDE PARTS OF SECTIONS 19, 20 30 & 31 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 72 BUT NOT DATED, SAID THAT **HE SET A TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" THAT MEASURES 2" AT THE TOP, 12" TALL, AND 6" AT THE BASE** FOR THE SOUTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11 ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS AGREEMENT SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 25 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887 WITH THE NOTATION THAT IT WAS SURVEYED OCTOBER 27 & 28 AND NOVEMBER 6-8, 1884, WITH A COPY OF THIS SURVEY FILED AS SURVEY F19001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-11.

- 1) 2,007' EAST TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11, AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 4
  - 2) 1,320' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-11
  - 3) 2,640' WEST TO THE 3" X 18" X 12" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11
  - 4) 3,960' WEST TO THE 3" X 18" X 12" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11
  - 5) 5,280' WEST TO THE 3" X 18" X 12" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11
  - 6) 6,643' WEST TO THE 4" X 12" X 18" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE RANGE LINE
  - 7) 9,285' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
  - 8) 1,315' NORTH TO THE 12" X 16" X 3" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11
  - 9) 2,630' NORTH TO THE 14" X 24" X 3" THICK LIMESTONE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11
  - 10) 3,945' NORTH TO THE 16" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11
  - 11) 5,260' NORTH TO THE 10" X 10" X 3" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 63, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 142 AND DATED JANUARY 6, 1903, ORDERED BY G. H. FILNER FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES AND SUBDIVISIONS OF SECTION 29 AND SECTION 32 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11, AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-15-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. - 2) 20.01 CHAINS EAST TO THE 14" X 10" X 3" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-15-11
- 3) 30.41 CHAINS EAST TO THE INTERSECTION OF THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 20-15-11 AND THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 1 ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29-15-11, LOCATED 30 FEET SOUTH OF A STONE WALL – NO MONUMENT MENTIONED
