

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 282 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 & 30-15-11.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.10 CHAINS WEST TO THE 20" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19 & 30-15-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 24" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19, 20, 29 & 30-15-11

- 2) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 72, AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR GEORGE MOSS AND GEORGE W, GORMAN TO SURVEY AND SUBDIVIDE PARTS OF SECTIONS 19, 20 30 & 31 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 72 BUT NOT DATED, SAID THAT **HE SET A 3" X 18" X 12" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE MARKED "1/4"** FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11, AND AT 2,640' WEST OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 25 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887 WITH THE NOTATION THAT IT WAS SURVEYED OCTOBER 27 & 28 AND NOVEMBER 6-8, 1884, WITH A COPY OF THIS SURVEY FILED AS SURVEY F19001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-11.

- 1) 1,320' WEST TO THE 3" X 18" X 12" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11
- 2) 3,683' WEST TO THE 4" X 12" X 18" LIME STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE RANGE LINE
- 3) 5,325' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
- 4) 1,320' EAST TO THE 3" X 18" X 12" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-11
- 5) 2,640' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11
- 6) 3,960' EAST TO THE 6" X 12" X 2" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 20-15-11
- 7) 5,967' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29-15-11
- 8) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE 3" X 16" X 10" TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 30-15-11
- 9) 2,640' SOUTH TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11
