

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 283 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 16" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 30 & 31-15-11.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.40 CHAINS WEST TO THE 16" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-15-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 29, 30, 31 & 32

- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN **INFORMAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 156 DATED MAY 29, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF C. KELLNER TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE 1/8TH CORNERS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH LINES OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 25-15-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 ON THIS **INFORMAL SURVEY**. HE USED THIS STONE TO SET THE STONE FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10 ON THE RANGE LINE.

- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 28, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 28 DATED APRIL 29-MAY 1, 1884 AT THE ORDER OF CASPER KELLNER TO SURVEY THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 25-15-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11. HE USED THIS STONE AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 TO SET THE STONE FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,663' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10 ON THE RANGE LINE
 - 2) 3,983' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 25-15-10
 - 3) 5,303' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
 - 4) 7,943' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10

- 4) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 72, AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR GEORGE MOSS AND GEORGE W. GORMAN TO SURVEY AND SUBDIVIDE PARTS OF SECTIONS 19, 20 30 & 31 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 72 BUT NOT DATED, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS AGREEMENT SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 25 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887 WITH THE NOTATION THAT IT WAS SURVEYED OCTOBER 27 & 28 AND NOVEMBER 6-8, 1884, WITH A COPY OF THIS SURVEY FILED AS SURVEY F19001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-11.

- 5) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 63, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 142 AND DATED JANUARY 6, 1903, ORDERED BY G. H. FILNER FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES AND SUBDIVISIONS OF SECTION 29 AND SECTION 32 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11, AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE BY A POST WHERE WIRES JOIN** AT

THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-11. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 3 ON PAGE 104 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS. SEE PACKET "M 137" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER 7 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 1) 39.96 CHAINS EAST TO THE 22" X 12" X 3" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29-15-11
- 2) 59.94 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE 16" X 10" X 6" HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-11
- 3) 79.92 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-11
- 4) 90.28 CHAINS EAST TO THE 24" X 10" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT FRACTIONAL CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 29 & 32-15-11 ON THE INDIAN LINE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 1 ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-11
