

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 28 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 16" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-15-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON JANUARY 10, 1861.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.40 CHAINS EAST TO THE 18" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 30 & 31-15-11
 - 2) 80.40 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 29, 30, 21 & 32-15-11
 - 3) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 20" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-11
 - 4) 80.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 32" X 18" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON A SLOPE TO THE NORTHWEST AT THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 16 & 16 SOUTH, RANGES 10 & 11 EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN **INFORMAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 156 DATED MAY 29, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF C. KELLNER TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE 1/8TH CORNERS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH LINES OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 25-15-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 OVER THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 WITH THE LINE NORTH FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-10 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL ON THIS **INFORMAL SURVEY**.

 - 2) 79.94-2/3 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE LOCATION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
 - 3) 119.92 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24-15-10
 - 4) 20.03-3/4 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 25-15-10
 - 5) 40.07-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
 - 6) 80.15 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 28, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 28 DATED APRIL 29-MAY 1, 1884 AT THE ORDER OF CASPER KELLNER TO SURVEY THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 25-15-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10 ON THE RANGE LINE BASED ON THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10 AND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 2,663' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11
 - 2) 1,320' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 25-15-10

- 3) 2,640' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
- 4) 5,280' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
- 5) 2,643.5' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10

- 6) 5,287.0' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10
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- 4) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 72, AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR GEORGE MOSS AND GEORGE W, GORMAN TO SURVEY AND SUBDIVIDE PARTS OF SECTIONS 19, 20 30 & 31 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 72 BUT NOT DATED, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 25 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887 WITH THE NOTATION THAT IT WAS SURVEYED OCTOBER 27 & 28 AND NOVEMBER 6-8, 1884, WITH A COPY OF THIS SURVEY FILED AS SURVEY F19001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-11.

 - 5) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 132, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY RECORD BOOK "E" ON PAGE 123 FOR ROAD A ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 15-10 AND 15-11 FOR G. W. GORMAN, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, DATED DECEMBER 20, 1885, **APPARENTLY FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES WITH A DEVIATION IN THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-15-10 TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22-15-10 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-11 TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY
