

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 28 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON JANUARY 10TH, 1861.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 16" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-15-11
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 32" X 18" X 5" THEY SET ON A SLOPE TO THE NORTHWEST AT THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGES 10 & 11 EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 50 AND DATED MARCH 1883, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-11 ON THE RANGE LINE TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY.
- 3) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN **INFORMAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 156 AND DATED MAY 1883, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-11 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS **INFORMAL SURVEY**.
