

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 441 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 & 22-15-12 ON THE COUNTY LINE. THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 39.62-1/2 CHAINS WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 22" X 5" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 15, 16 21 & 22-15-12
  - 2) 39.62-1/2 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 22" X 12" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 14, 15, 22 & 23-15-12
  
- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 23 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 90 TO 92 FOR A PETITION BY SIDNEY PUTMAN AND OTHERS COR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 15-12 AND 16-12 [PACKET 128 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON JUNE 4, 1879, WAS ESTABLISHED ON JULY 7, 1879, AND WAS RECORDED ON JULY 11, 1879 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22-15-12 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY. FROM THE BEGINNING OF SAID ROAD TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-16-12 THE ROAD SHALL BE 50 FEET WIDE, AND THE BALANCE OF SAID ROAD IS TO BE 60 FEET WIDE.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) THIS 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 34-15-12 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL; THEN EXTENDS EAST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL FOR 10 RODS AND 15 LINKS TO A TURN TO THE SOUTH
  
- 3) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A PLAT OF SURVEY OF SECTION 22-15-12, TO ESTABLISH THE LINES AND CORNERS OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF SECTION 22 MADE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE W. D. DEANS, COUNTY SURVEYOR OF WABAUNSEE COUNTY AND MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR OF LYON COUNTY ON JULY 18, 19 & 20, 1889 AT THE REQUEST OF S. HOLMES, AND RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 41 ON PGE 528 AT THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JULY 24, 1889, SAID THAT **HE SET A LIMESTONE 15" X 18" X 5" MARKED "1/4" ON THE NORTH FACE** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-15-13 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22-15-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
  
- 4) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 124  
ON MARCH 24, 1961, A PETITION SIGNED BY CLARENCE J. HEDMAN AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 15-12 WAS PRESENTED TO W. A. STOLFUS, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND W. D. KRETSINGER, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON APRIL 15, 1960 AND THE FINAL ORDER DATED FEBRUARY 15, 1960 **VACATED** THE FOLLOWING ROAD:
  - 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 22-15-12, THENCE RUNNING WEST 1/2 MILE ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE
