- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 14 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 111 DATED FEBRUARY 13, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF J. BANNICK'S AND J. WILLIAMS LAND, BEING A DIVISION OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 26, AND THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-15-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-15-12 EQUIDISTANT FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 20 CHAINS, 7-1/2 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-12
- 2) 20 CHAINS, 7-1/2 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-12
