

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 440 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 12" X 5"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 27 & 28-15-12.

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 118 DATED JULY 13, 1882 ORDERED BY A. T. OLIN TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS TO THE NORTH 1/2 OF SECTION 28-15-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 14" X 12" X 2" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,645' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12
 - 2) 2,645' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-2
 - 3) 5,364' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12

- 3) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, BY J. MAX YINGLING, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGES 87 & 88 AT THE REQUEST OF W. D. BUCHANAN TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-15-12, SAID THAT **HE PLANTED AN 18" X 9" X 6" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/4" ON THE WEST SIDE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE SET THIS CORNER ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12. THE FIELD SURVEY WAS ON SEPTEMBER 12 TO 15, 1911 AND ENTERED ON JANUARY 2, 1912. SEE ALSO PACKET "M 168" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,643' NORTH TO THE 24" X 7" X 6" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH 3 NOTCHES ON THE WEST SIDE AND 2 NOTCHES ON THE NORTH SIDE HE PLANTED FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12
 - 2) 2,643' SOUTH TO THE 18" X 10" X 6-1/2" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH 3 NOTCHES ON THE WEST SIDE AND ONE NOTCH ON THE NORTH SIDE HE PLANTED FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12

- 4) W. D. KRETSINGER, L.S. 363, COUNTY ENGINEER, BY LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 15 AT THE REQUEST OF FRED BOLINE TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12 THAT WAS BEGAN ON MARCH 22, 1956 AND CONTINUED UNTIL THE SURVEY WAS COMPLETED ON MARCH 29, 1956, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ONE DAY, NAMELY MARCH 27, SAID THAT HE SET A **TEMPORARY POINT** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12 ON A LINE OVER THE YINGLING STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-15-12 AND THE YINGLING STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12, AND AT DOUBLE THE DISTANCE THAT HE MEASURED BETWEEN THESE TWO STONES ON THIS **PERMANENT**

SURVEY. HE SAID TO REFER TO THE MAX YINGLING SURVEY IN 1911 RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 87 FOR THE ORIGIN OF THE STONES.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 2,668' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12 THAT WAS SET BY YINGLING IN THE 1911 PERMANENT SURVEY
 - 2) 4,002' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 28-15-12 THAT WAS SET BY YINGLING IN THE 1911 PERMANENT SURVEY
 - 3) 2,643' SOUTH TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12
- 5) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 60 AT THE REQUEST OF KEITH ROLAND TO ESTABLISH THE LINE BETWEEN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-15-12, DOES **NOT** MENTION IF HE SEARCHED FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
