

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 444 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 15" X 2-1/2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 31 & 31-15-12.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 39.89 CHAINS WEST TO THE 16" X 13" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-15-12 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 14" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 29, 30, 31 & 32-15-12

- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 138 DATED DECEMBER 19, 1882 THROUGH JANUARY 3, 1883 ORDERED BY GEORGE W. DeCAMP TO SURVEY SECTIONS 31 & 32 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 80.18 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-12 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
 - 2) 20.07 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 31
 - 3) 40.14 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-12
 - 4) 20.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 31-15-12
 - 5) 39.77 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-12 ON THE RANGE LINE
