

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 138 DATED DECEMBER 19, 1882 THROUGH JANUARY 3, 1883 ORDERED BY GEORGE W. DeCAMP TO SURVEY SECTIONS 31 & 32 IN TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
  
- 2) J. HARRISON PARKMAN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1907 TO 1915, BY J. MAX YINGLING, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 154, TERM 2, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 75 DATED FEBRUARY 25-27, 1909 TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 32-15-12, SAID THAT **HE PLANTED A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**, "HAVING DIVIDED THE SURPLUS LAND EQUALLY IN THE FOUR QUARTER SECTIONS IN SAID SECTION".  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 1,322.5' EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-12
  - 2) 2,645' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-12
  
- 3) J. HARRISON PARKMAN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1907 TO 1915, BY J. MAX YINGLING, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 44 DATED DECEMBER 1909 FOR A ROAD RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGE 437, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND A STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
