

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) J. HARRISON PARKMAN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1907 TO 1915, BY J. MAX YINGLING, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 154, TERM 2, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 75 DATED FEBRUARY 25-27, 1909 TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 32-15-12, SAID THAT **HE PLANTED A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,322.5' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-12
 - 2) 1,327.5' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-12
 - 3) 1,327.5' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-12

- 2) KIM LOUIS HUXMAN, L.S. 975, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 12, 2004, FOR KDOT PROJECT 99-56-K7443-01, SURVEY F28001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 15-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 6" X 6" X 14" LIMESTONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-12. HE IDENTIFIED THIS STONE AS THE CORNERSTONE THAT WAS SET BY J. MAX YINGLING, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A RECORDED SURVEY DATED FEBRUARY, 1909, IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 75. **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM KDOT CAP AT 0.25 FEET EAST OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE STONE.** KDOT CORNER NUMBER 32065
 - 1) 1.5' NNE TO THE CENTERLINE BOTTOM OF AN 8" HEDGE CORNER POST
 - 2) 9.2' WEST TO THE CENTERLINE BOTTOM OF AN 8" HEDGE BRACE POST
 - 3) 8.9' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE BOTTOM OF AN 8" HEDGE BRACE POST
 - 4) IN LINE WITH OLD FENCE REMNANTS TO THE WEST AND SOUTHHIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,326.99' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-12
 - 2) 1,313.93' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM KDOT CAP HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-12
