

CENTER CORNER SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 13 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 109 DATED FEBRUARY 12, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF MARION WEAVER'S LAND, BEING THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-15-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY.

- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 168 ORDERED BY J. E. LEEPER TO LOCATE THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE LINES AND CORNERS OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-15-12 DATED MAY 5-7, 1887, SAID THAT HE SET A **TEMPORARY STAKE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-15-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,330' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 33-15-12
 - 2) 2,660' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-15-12
 - 3) 1,317' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 33
 - 4) 2,634' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-15-12
