- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 168 ORDERED BY J. E. LEEPER TO LOCATE THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE LINES AND CORNERS OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-15-12 DATED MAY 5-7, 1887, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-15-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-15-12 AND THE TEMPORARY STAKE THAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-15-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,330' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-15-12
- 2) 1,330' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-15-12
