

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 10 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 108 AND DATED JANUARY 1868, SAID THAT **HE SET A TEMPORARY POST** FOR THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12
- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 108 DATED JANUARY 24, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF JAMES McCOY'S LAND, BEING THE SURVEY OF A LINE BETWEEN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE CORNER "PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED"** AT THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12 AS PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED
- 3) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 14 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 111 DATED FEBRUARY 13, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF J. BANNICK'S AND J. WILLIAMS LAND, BEING A DIVISION OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 26, AND THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-15-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-15-12 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-21 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20 CHAINS, 14-1/2 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-12
- 2) 20 CHAINS, 14-1/2 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-15-12
