

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 10 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 108 AND DATED JANUARY 1868, SAID THAT **HE ESTABLISHED** THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12 AT 19 CHAINS, 93 LINKS WEST OF THE STONE AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 35-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY. HE DID NOT DESCRIBE THE MONUMENT THAT HE SET AT THIS CORNER.

HIS NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12

2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 108 DATED JANUARY 24, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF JAMES McCOY'S LAND, BEING THE SURVEY OF A LINE BETWEEN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE CORNER "PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED"** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY. HE DID NOT DESCRIBE THE MONUMENT THAT HE FOUND AT THIS CORNER.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12 THAT WAS "PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED" – NOT DESCRIBED
