

CENTER CORNER SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 24 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 119 & 120 DATED MARCH 5, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF B. PUTMAN'S, L. HATHAWAY'S, AND P. JOHNSON'S LAND, BEING THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12, SAID THAT HE RAN THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS. HE SET A TEMPORARY POST AT 160 RODS EAST OF THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-15-12, AND A TEMPORARY POST AT 160 RODS NORTH OF THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-15-12. SINCE THE POSTS WERE NOT AT THE SAME POINT, HE PROJECTED ANGLES AND AT THE PROPER POINT **HE ESTABLISHED** THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12. HE DID **NOT** SAY IF HE SET A POST OR A STONE FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12.
- 2) REA BOOK 30 ON PAGE 24.5 SAYS THAT **THEY ESTABLISHED** THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12 AT 2,633 FEET NORTH OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12 AND IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE EAST. **VERIFY BEFORE USING AS IT WAS PROBABLY "HEELED-IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
 - 1) 32' EAST TO A WITNESS PIN IN THE EAST END OF A FENCE FROM THE EAST
- 3) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 15-12 SHOWS A **REA PIN** AT THE "SW CORNER NE1/4 SECTION 36-15-12". **VERIFY AND BEFORE USING!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
 - 1) 32' EAST TO A WITNESS [REA]
- 4) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 28, 1996, FOR JOB NUMBER 96254-02, SAID THAT HE SEARCHED FOR THE STONE AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. HE DID **NOT** RESET THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY.
