

SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 24 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 119 & 120 DATED MARCH 5, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF B. PUTMAN'S, L. HATHAWAY'S, AND P. JOHNSON'S LAND, BEING THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 36-15-12 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL EQUIDISTANT FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 80 RODS, 3-3/4 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12
- 2) 80 RODS, 3-3/4 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12
- 3) 80 RODS NORTH TO THE "ESTABLISHED" CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 36-15-12 - NOT DESCRIBED
- 4) 160 RODS NORTH TO THE "ESTABLISHED" NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 36-15-12 - NOT DESCRIBED
- 5) 240 RODS NORTH TO THE "PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED" NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 36-15-12 - NOT DESCRIBED
