

**NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 27 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 17" X 14" X 2-1/2"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 18 & 19-15-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 38.20 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 16" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 18 & 19-15-13
  - 2) 78.20 CHAINS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 20" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 & 20-15-13
  - 3) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 24" X 10" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-13
  - 4) 80.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 16" X 13" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19 & 30-15-13
- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, BY D. W. BOWMAN, DEPUTY, IN SURVEY NUMBER 59 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 158 DATED MAY 23, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF THE LAND OWNED BY JOHNSON, ROSE AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 19-15-13, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND DIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 INTO TWO EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-13 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 321 RODS, 3 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-13
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 26, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 26 DATED APRIL 21-23, 1884 TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-15-13 FOR CHARLES CHRIST, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-13 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 15 ON JANUARY 27, 1889 AT THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE AND AS SURVEY F19001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19, RANGE 13. HE USED THIS STONE AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-13 TO VERIFY THE DISPUTED LOCATION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-13 ON THE COUNTY LINE.

- 4) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 139, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 139 DATED SEPTEMBER 1 & 2, 1886 FOR S. HOLM, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, FOR A ROAD ON THE WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE, **APPARENTLY FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-13 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE FOR 7 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 24-15-11 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE FOR 1 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-13 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY

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- 5) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 340 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 310 TO 312 PETITIONED BY S. HOLM AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE IN TOWNSHIPS 15-11, 15-12 AND 15-13 [PACKET 562 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 1, 1886, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON OCTOBER 15, 1886 BY T. E. McMILLAN, CHAIRMAN OF THE LYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON MARCH 10, 1887 BY ROLAND LAKIN, LYON COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-13 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE COUNTY LINE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE COUNTY LINE FOR 7 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 24-15-11 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE FOR 1 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-15-13 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
