

EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) W. D. KRETSINGER, L.S. 363, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 103 DATED AUGUST 21, 1947, TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE DIVISION LINE BETWEEN THE NORTH 1/2 AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27 FOR H. L. SNODDY AND T. C. HAMACHER, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" WITNESS REBAR** IN THE FENCE AT A POINT **30 FEET WEST** OF THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-15-13 ON THE LYON AND OSAGE COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. **HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES FROM THE TRUE POSITION ON THE SECTION LINE:**
- 1) 1,325.37' NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE & 1" DIAMETER REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 27-15-13
 - 2) 1,325.38' SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE THEORETICAL LOCATION FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-15-13
 - 3) 3,976.13' SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 27-15-13
