

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 26 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 15" X 9" X 7"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTIONS 31-15-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 22" X 10" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-15-13
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 22" X 8" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET AT THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGES 12 & 13 EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
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- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 24 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 119 & 120 DATED MARCH 5, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF B. PUTMAN'S, L. HATHAWAY'S, AND P. JOHNSON'S LAND, BEING THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-15-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND** THE STONE AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS SURVEY.

- 1) 320 RODS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-15-12
