

**CENTER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 162 DATED SEPTEMBER 12 & 13, 1883 BY THE ORDER OF J. W. RULISON TO HAVE SECTION 32-15-13 SUBDIVIDED AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE ESTABLISHED, SAID THAT **HE SET A 13" X 9" X 4" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNERS ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 19.97-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE 20" X 12" X 5" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-13
- 2) 19.97-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE 15" X 8" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-13
