

CENTER CORNER NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 01, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 171 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 270 TO 272 PETITION BY ROBERT HENDERSON AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-10 [PACKET 405 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON JUNE 7, 1882, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE AND 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON OCTOBER 6, 1882 AS NOTED BY HUGH F. HOLMES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON OCTOBER 20, 1882 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY WAS AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE SANTA FE ROAD AT OR NEAR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/8TH CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SECTION 1-16-10; THEN CONTINUES AS A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1/4 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 11-16-10; THEN CONTINUES SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 11-16-10 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN INFORMAL SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 154 AND DATED APRIL 25, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF McFALL TO SURVEY SECTION 1-16-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10 AT 3/4 OF A MILE WEST OF THE STONE AT THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10 ON THIS INFORMAL SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1/4 MILE EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 1-18-10
- 2) 1/2 MILE EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10
- 3) 3/4 MILE EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 121, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 121 DATED SEPTEMBER 14 & 15, 1885 ORDERED BY SAMUEL RALY TO SURVEY AND LOCATE THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 4" X 7" X 16" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8"** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10 ON LINE AND AT THE PROPORTIONAL DISTANCE BETWEEN THE TEMPORARY STAKE THAT HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10 AND THE TEMPORARY STAKE THAT HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 1,315.5' WEST TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10
- 2) 3,946.5' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10
