

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 136 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT THEY INTERSECTED THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL 296 LINKS WEST OF THE STANDARD CORNER TO SECTIONS 33 & 34 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL, AND **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 14" X 4"** FOR THE **CLOSING CORNER** TO SECTIONS 3 & 4-16-10 ON MARCH 7, 1861.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 37.29 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 18" X 11" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 3 & 4-16-10
 - 2) 77.29 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 26" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 3, 4, 9 & 10-16-10

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 113 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 38 TO 40 PETITIONED BY JESSE LEYTON AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-10 [PACKET 362 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MAY 31, 1881, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JULY 15, 1881 AS NOTED BY J. W. GRIFFITH, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JULY 8, 1881 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-16-10 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO AN ANGLE TO THE SOUTHEASTERLY DUE TO ROCK CREEK AT 4.80 CHAINS SOUTH OF THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9-16-10; THEN INTERSECTS THE SECTION LINE AT 412 FEET NORTH OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-16-10; THEN CONTINUES SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE LEFT PAGE 220 BUT NOT DATED, FOR A ROAD SURVEY IN TOWNSHIP 16-10 APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-16-10 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO AN ANGLE TO THE SOUTHEASTERLY DUE TO ROCK CREEK AT 4.80 CHAINS SOUTH OF THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 9-16-10; THEN INTERSECTS THE SECTION LINE AT 412 FEET NORTH OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-16-10; THEN CONTINUES SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 4) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 28 DATED AUGUST 23, 1882, FOR A ROAD SURVEY ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL IN TOWNSHIPS 15 & 16, RANGE 10 FOR R. EDEN, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-10 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL AS HE RAN THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-15-10 TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-10 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. NO WIDTH IS RECORDED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

- 5) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 137 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 334 TO 336 PETITIONED BY RICHARD EDEN AND OTHERS TO VACATE AND RELOCATE A COUNTY ROAD ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL BETWEEN TOWNSHIPS 15-10 & 16-10 [PACKET 406 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON AUGUST 23, 1882, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON OCTOBER 6, 1882 AS NOTED BY HUGH F. HOLMES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON OCTOBER 24, 1882 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-16-10 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY. THE ROAD **VACATED** WAS ALL THAT PART OF THE SANTA FE ROAD THROUGH SECTIONS 2, 3 & 4-16-10 TO THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 2-16-10.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS RELOCATED ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-15-10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD RELOCATION SURVEY
- 2) THIS RELOCATED ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-10; THEN EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE EAST SIDE OF SECTION 2-16-10 TO INTERSECT THE ROAD AS ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS RELOCATED ROAD
