

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 136 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 14" X 11" X 4"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 3 & 4-16-10.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 37.29 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 20" X 14" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CLOSING CORNER TO SECTIONS 3 & 4-16-10 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 26" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 3, 4, 9 & 10-16-10

- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 4, 2000, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 00126-02, A SURVEY OF THE ENTRANCE TO THE OLD MISSILE BASE ON COUNTY ROAD "D" FOR THE LYON COUNTY SHERIFF & THE K. B. I., SAID THAT HE CONSIDERED THAT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-10 WAS **OBLITERATED**. **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-10 BASED ON THE PHYSICAL EVIDENCE THAT HE FOUND AT THIS CORNER.
 - 1) IN LINE WITH FENCES TO THE EAST AND WEST [EXTENDED]
 - 2) 31.55' SW TO A SPIKE & WASHER IN AN 8" LOCUST TREE
 - 3) 19.55' WEST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 4) 24.7' EAST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 5) 2,652.23' SOUTH TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-10
