

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 38 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 16" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE ON DECEMBER 30, 1860, FROM WHICH:
  - 1) A WHITE OAK TREE 14" IN DIAMETER BEARS N. 74° E. AT 9 LINKS DISTANCE
  - 2) A MULBERRY TREE 10" IN DIAMETER BEARS S. 80° W. AT 53 LINKS DISTANCE

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

  - 1) 38.23 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 18" X 12" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CLOSING CORNER AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 10" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 6 & 7-16-10
  
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 5, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 185 DATED APRIL 2-4 AND MAY 8-9, 1900 AT THE ORDER OF THE RICHARDS BROTHERS FOR A SURVEY OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-10, SAID THAT HE FOUND A WITNESS TREE FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE WITH A **STONE** LOCATED 7 LINKS SOUTHWEST OF THE TREE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE SAID THAT THERE WERE NO MARKS ON THE STONE. THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 50" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE. HE USED THE STONE FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

  - 1) 38.21 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STANDARD CORNER STONE HE FOUND AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL
  - 2) 19.95 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 16" X 8" X 3" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-10
  - 3) 39.89 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10, THAT STANDS MIDWAY BETWEEN 2 STONE POSTS
