

**WEST 1/16 CORNER SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 5, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 185 DATED APRIL 2-4 AND MAY 8-9, 1900 AT THE ORDER OF THE RICHARDS BROTHERS FOR A SURVEY OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 16" X 8" X 3" STONE THAT WAS ROUND ON ONE SIDE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE MIDWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 50" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.  
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 19.94 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10 THAT STANDS MIDWAY BETWEEN 2 STONE POSTS
  - 2) 19.95 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10
  - 3) 58.16 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STANDARD CORNER STONE HE FOUND AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-10
  - 4) 17.33 CHAINS EAST TO THE 17" X 9" X 5" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-10
