

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F10001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-10 DATED SEPTEMBER 2, 1910 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10230-02, A SURVEY OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10 FOR JIM MASTERS, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10 TO BE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT MONUMENTED** ON THIS SURVEY.  
**HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
- 1) 1,329.48' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
  - 2) 2,658.95' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH "CLS 27" CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
  - 3) 2,648.04' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 757" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
  - 4) 2,669.66' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
  - 5) 1,328.60' SOUTH TO THE THEORETICAL LOCATION FOR THE EAST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
  - 6) 2,657.61' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10

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
