

NORTH 1/16 CORNER SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F10001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-10 DATED SEPTEMBER 2, 1910 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10230-02, A SURVEY OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10 FOR JIM MASTERS, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10 TO BE ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10 AND THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10, BUT THAT THE POSITION WAS **NOT MONUMENTED** ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,329.47' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH "CLS 27" CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
- 2) 1,329.48' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
- 3) 3,999.14' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
- 4) 1,326.63' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
- 5) 2,653.26' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-10
