

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 60, A ROAD SURVEY FOR A ROAD BETWEEN SECTIONS 7 AND 18, TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 10 AT THE REQUEST OF J. J. WINGFIELD, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER. RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 139 DATED APRIL 15, 1902, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A STONE MARKED "1/8"** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-16-10 FOR THE END OF THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD, BEING 20 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE SURVEYED LINE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINE TO THE ANGLE STONE THAT HE SET AT 18.21 CHAINS EAST OF THE 12" X 12" X 3" STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7-16-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE
