

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 130 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 16" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 23 & 26-16-10.
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGE 578 FOR ROAD NUMBER 248 DATED JANUARY 1884, SAID THAT **HE FOUND** THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-16-10 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
- 3) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, IN SURVEY NUMBER 165, AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 135 DATED JULY 10-13, 1888 FOR LESTER NOPPER AND F. WILLIAMSON TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, THE CORNERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 , ALL IN SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE SET A FLAG** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-16-10 AFTER HE RAN THE SECTION LINES FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27-16-10 TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-16-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS FILED IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 414 ON OCTOBER 18, 1888 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE AND SURVEY F27001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-10 IS A COPY OF THE RECORDED SURVEY.
