WILLIAMSON TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, THE CORNERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 , ALL IN SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 15" X 9" X 3" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A PLUS ("+") NEAR THE BOTTOM ON THE WEST SIDE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 27-16-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS FILED IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 414 ON OCTOBER 18, 1888 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE AND SURVEY F27001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-10 IS A COPY OF THE RECORDED SURVEY.
